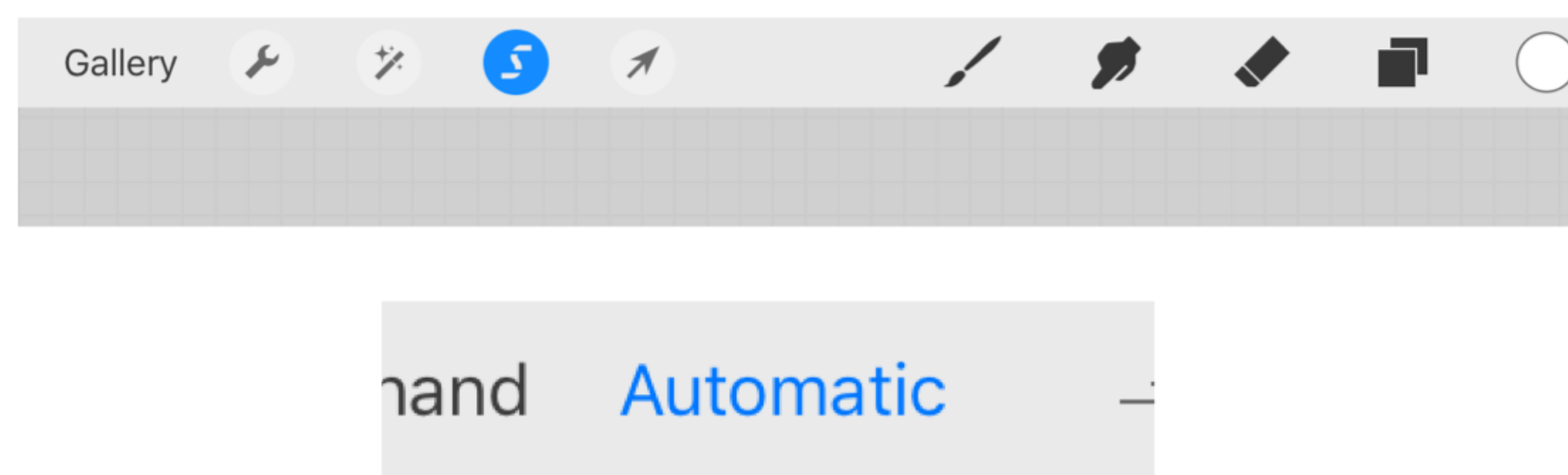




- 1) Fill a layer with white.
- 2) On that same layer (IMPORTANT), start lettering with the Metallic Letter brush using a fuschia color.
- 3) Press your selection tool and set it to automatic (see picture below).



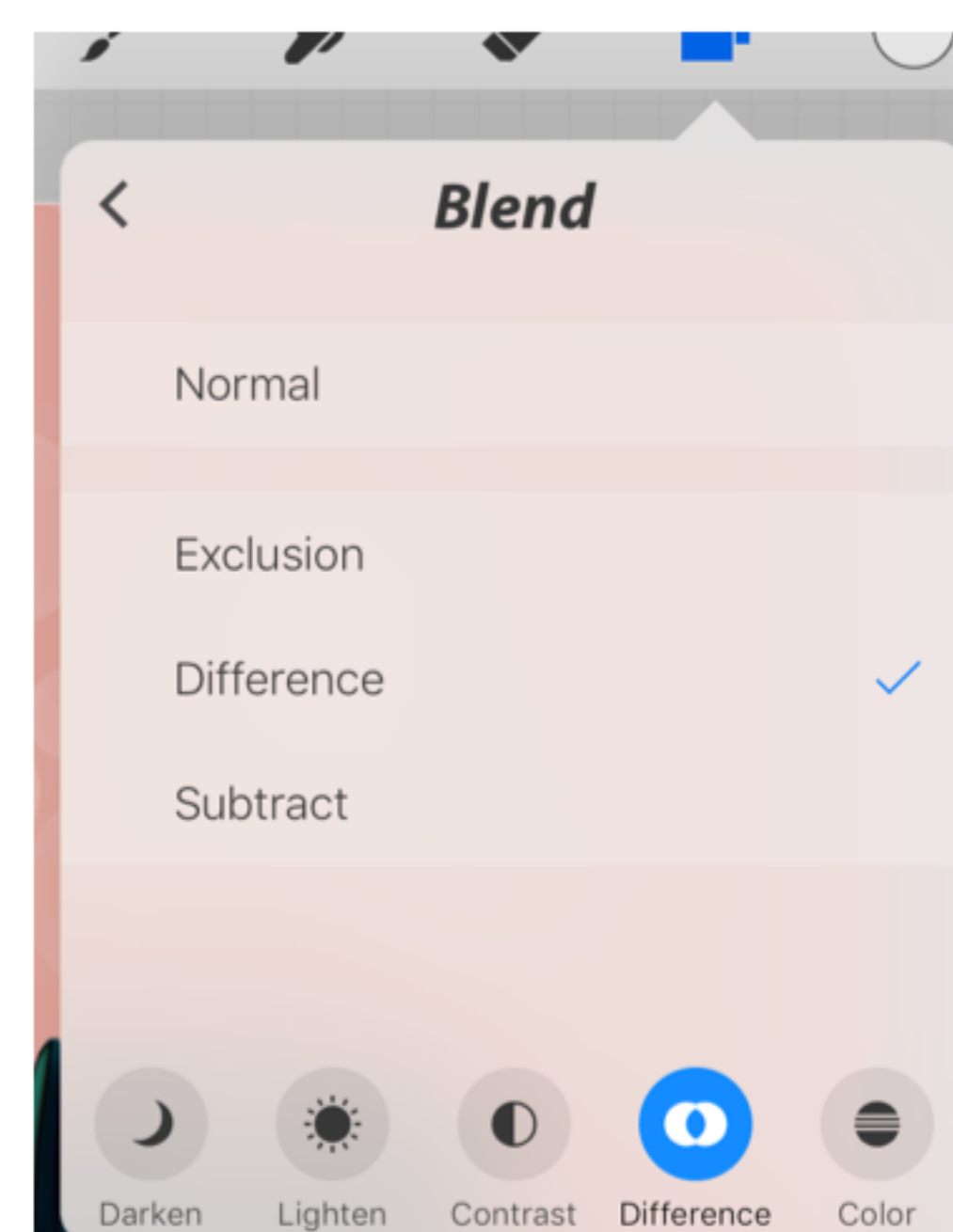
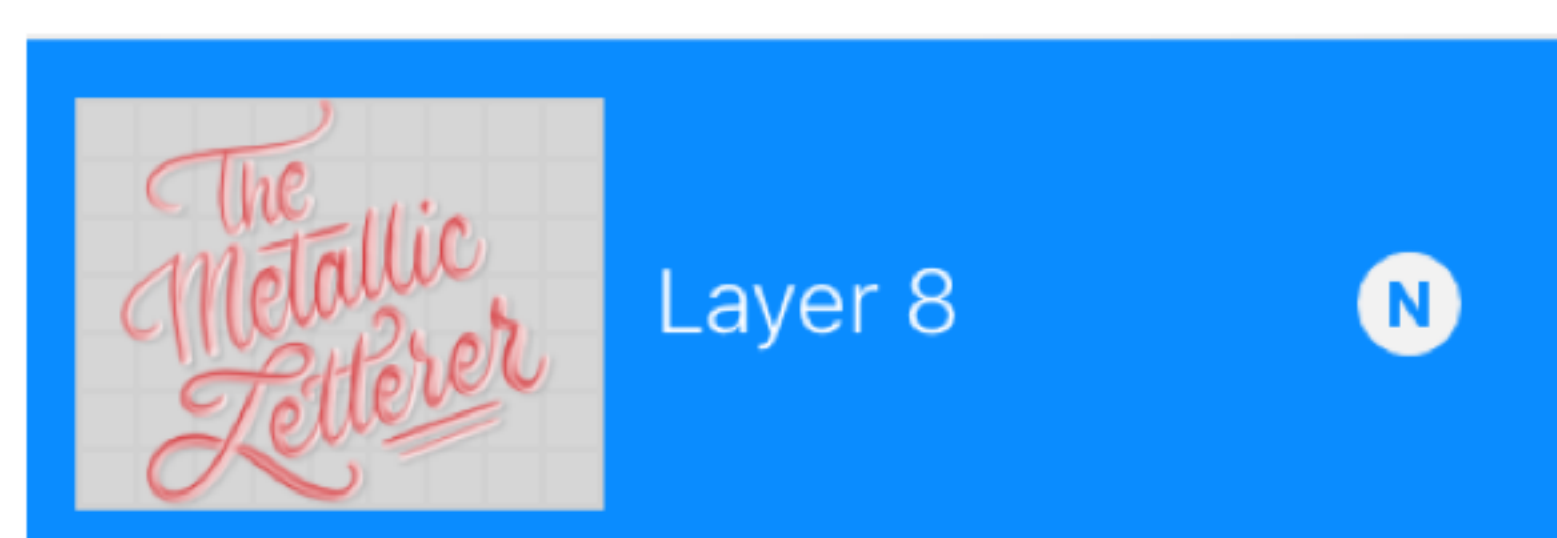
- 1) Fill a layer with white.
- 2) On that same layer (IMPORTANT), start lettering with the Metallic Letter brush using a yellow/green color.
- 3) Press your selection tool and set it to automatic (see picture below).



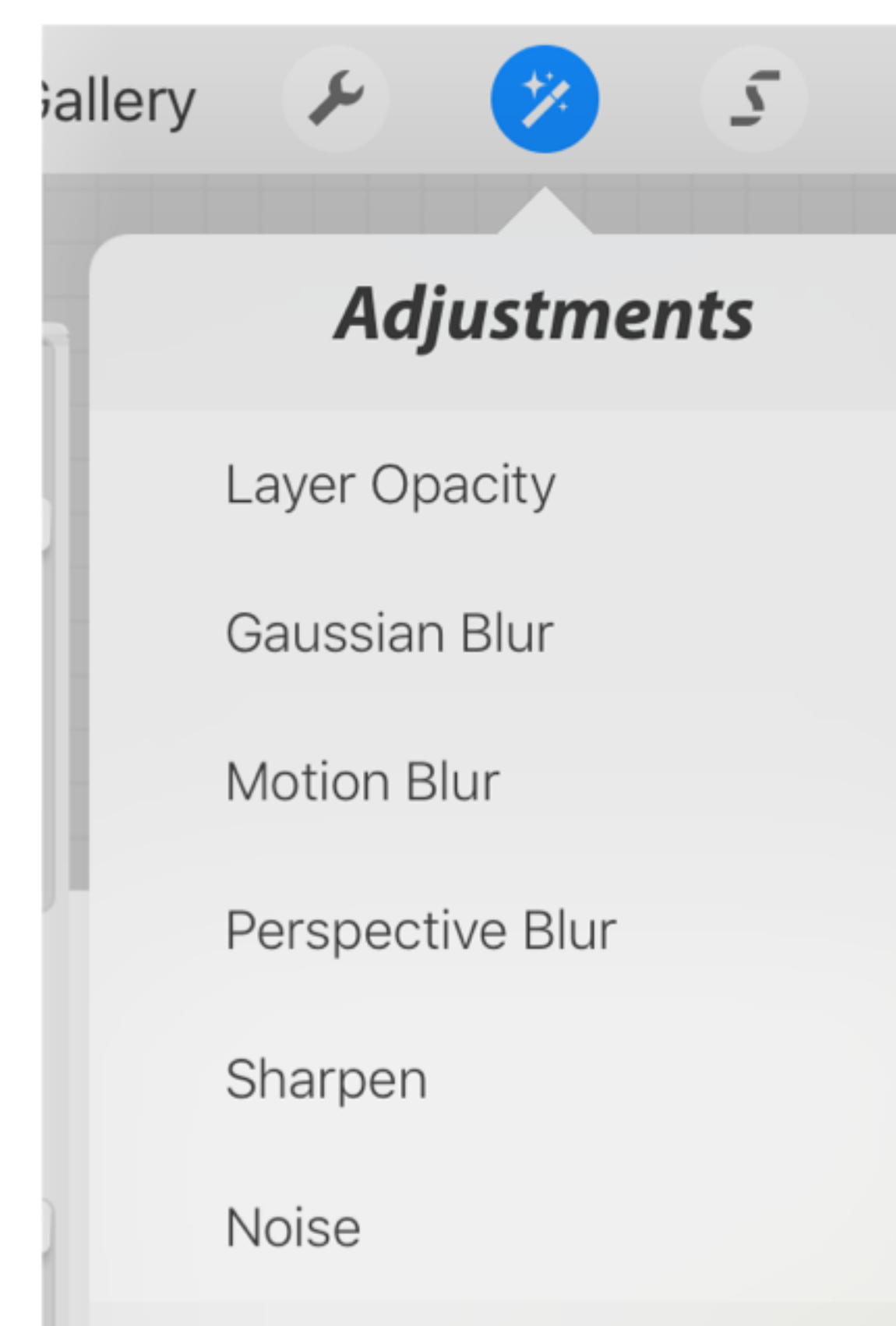
- 4) Select all areas that are white (they turn to black), long press to cut. Your lettering should now be isolated.
- 5) Create a colored layer under your lettered layer, I chose yellow.



6) To create this look to the left, press the lettered layer > N, once in blend mode press Difference > Difference. Color may vary.



- 4) Select all areas that are white (they turn to black), long press to cut. Your lettering should now be isolated.
- 5) Create a colored layer under your lettered layer, I chose turquoise.



6) Select your lettered layer and click on adjustments > noise. Toggle to add a slight shimmer to your lettering.
